- All students take a year-long or semester Health and P.E. course, however an "opt out" is available for 8th Graders in Earth Science, World Language, and Year-long Fine Arts if preferred electives are aligned with Academic \& Career Plan

## Math and English Placement

- MCPS provides a comprehensive mathematics and English/Language Arts program to promote the achievement of every student.
- A key component of our program is ensuring that all secondary students are placed in English and mathematics courses that deliver an appropriate level of challenge.
- Each MCPS middle school collects and analyzes multiple pieces of student data in order to make placement decisions, including grades, SOL test scores, MAP data reports, readiness assessments, and teacher recommendations.


## Intervention Course Placement

- Reading and Writing Intervention Course
- Intervention courses are in addition to grade-level English courses
- Designed for students who have been identified as needing increased support in order to be successful in reading
- Students will be scheduled for these courses based on a variety of criteria, including grades, SOL test scores, MAP report data, and screening assessments.
